## Black & White Hexagons



## **Supplies**

- Heartfelt Hexagon Stamp Set
- Hexagon punch
- Black cardstock
- 3 different papers from the Zoo Crew Designer Series Paper Set
- White card stock + scrap about
  7cm x 6cm (3-1/4" x 2-1/2")
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink
- 1/4" Black & White Gingham Ribbon cut to 19cm (7-1/2")
- Adhesive Backed Sparkle Gems
- Multi Purpose Liquid Glue

## **Directions**

- Cut black card stock to 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2"), score at 10.5cm (4-1/4") and fold in half.
- Cut white card stock to 10cm x 14.3cm (4" x 5-1/4") and glue to inside of card for a liner to write on.
- Punch out three hexagons of each pattern from the patterned paper.
- From the scrap of white card stock punch out a white hexagon.
- Stamp your greeting onto the white hexagon. If you have the card kit I have included two greetings for you to choose from: one birthday and one encouragement.



 Decide where you would like to put your greeting, you can use the card in the upright position with the opening on the right or you can use it horizontally with the opening at the bottom.
 What ever your mood!

- Fold the ribbon in half and glue to the back side of your greeting hexagon (see photo) trim the ends. Place 4 dimentionals on the back side of the greeting and affix to card.
- Arrange the hexagon around the greeting and glue down. I left about a 2cm to 5mm (1/8" to 1/4") between the hexagons so the black card would show through. (Photo above)
- Trim down the hexagons that are sticking out, place your bling and you are done!
