

Simple Thank You Card



Supplies

Thoughtful Moments Hybrid
Embossing Folder
Crumb Cake Card Stock
Lost Lagoon Stampin Pad &
Stampin Brayer
Alternative to brayer - Lost
Lagoon Stampin Write
Sunny Day Designer Series Paper
Linen Thread
Tinsel Gems Three Pack
Stampin Dimensionals

Directions

- Using Crumb Cake card stock cut a card base, 14.85cm x 21cm (5" x 8-1/2"). Score at half way mark, 10.5cm (4-1/4") fold and burnish.
- Cut two pieces of the Sunny Day Designer Series Paper to 14.85cm x 3.4cm (5" x 1-5/8") Adhere to the top and bottom of the front of the card base.
- Using a brayer, roll several times onto the Lost Lagoon Stampin Pad to evenly ink up a strip on the brayer. Run the brayer over the inside of the embossing folder over the words Thank You. When the folder is open, you want to ink up the right side. See photo next page.



- Alternatively you could use the Stampin Writer marker to color the raised edges of the words Thank You. Be sure you are using the side of the brush tip. Any overflow to the inside or outside of the lines will create a blurry uneven line around the letters. This requires a steady hand; I found using the brayer was much faster and easier.

- Position the cutting plate over the freshly inked side of the folder and place your paper on top of that. I only used a small scrap of the Crumb Cake card stock as I did not want any of the other words at this time.
- Run through your Cut & Emboss Machine with the embossing folder's folded edge running through the machine first. Be sure to clean the ink off of your embossing folder and die. This will easily wipe off with a Simply Shammy/damp cloth/baby wipe.
- Cut a piece of the Linen Thread to approximately 45cm (18"). Wrap the thread around the card front twice and tie a bow just off the center.
- Place two Stampin Dimensionals on the back of the Thank You and stick onto the card covering the Linen Thread to help keep it in place.
- For a bit of bling place three of the lovely Lost Lagoon Tinsel Gems from the Three Pack.
