# Flowers for You February Card Sketch

# **Supplies**

- Everyday Details Stamp Set
- Everyday Details Die Set
- Misty Moonlight Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Flight & Airy Designer Series
  Paper
- Water Color Pencils, Asst. 1 & 2

- Memento Tuxedo Black Ink Pad
- Stampin Dimensionals
- 2023 25In Color Dots
- 3/8" Sheer Ribbon (Bubble Bath)

#### **Directions**

Cut a side folded card base from the Misty Moonlight card stock, 14.85cm x 21cm (8-1/2" x 5-1/2"). Score at half way, 10.5cm (4-1/4") Fold and burnish.

From the basic white card stock cut a liner piece  $10 \text{cm} \times 14.4 \text{cm}$  (4" x 5-1/4"). I decorated the liner with a piece of the blue floral paper from the Flight & Airy Designer Series Paper approximately  $10 \text{cm} \times 4 \text{cm}$  (4" x 1-1/2").

## For The Layers, all cut from the Flight & Airy Designer Series Paper:

- Largest Layer, place down first: 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4") Leave a small equal border all the way around the card.
- Second Layer, 6cm x 7.2cm (2-3/8" x 2-7/8")This layer is placed toward the top, with the upper left corner near the left side of the card and the upper right corner tilted until it nearly touches the largest layer at the top.
- Third Layer, 6.5cm x 7cm (2-7/8" x 2-5/8") This layer is placed toward the bottom of the card, with the bottom left corner placed a little over a centimeter (1/2") away from the left side of the first layer and tilted down until the bottom right corner is nearly touching the edge of bottom layer.
- Fourth Layer, Cut a piece of the Bubble Bath Ribbon 11cm (4-1/2"). Tape or glue the edges to the back side of the largest layer. This will act as the center strip from the card sketch.
- Fifth Layer, is cut from a scrap of white card card stock using the largest of the rectangle dies from the Everyday Details die set. This layer is placed towards the right side of the largest layer, center top and bottom and leave an approximate equal border of a little over a centimeter (1/2") showing from the side of the first layer.

### **Directions** cont.

For this example of the card sketch I choose to stamp an image on the top most (5th) layer. I stamped the image with the Memento Tuxedo Black ink and colored it with the Water Color Pencils.

I raised the image up on Stampin Dimensionals and added some of the 2023-25 In Color Dots
