

Supplies

- Stippled Roses Stamp Set
- Peaceful Moments Stamp Set (Discontinued-see note)
- Pebbled Path Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Softly Stippled Designer Series
 Paper
- Pebbled Path Stampin Pad
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Sparkle Gems (optional)

Directions

Cut a side folded card base from the Pebbled Path card stock, 14.85cm x 21cm $(8-1/2 \times 5-1/2)$. Score at half way, 10.5cm (4-1/4) Fold and burnish.

From the basic white card stock cut a liner piece $10 \text{cm} \times 14.4 \text{cm}$ (4" x 5-1/4"). I decorated the liner with a piece of the Softly Stippled Designer Series Paper approximately $10 \text{cm} \times 2 \text{cm}$ (4" x 1/2").

The Layers, all cut from the Tool Time Designer Series Paper:

- Largest Layer, place down first: 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4") Leave a small equal border all the way around the card.
- Second Layer, 6cm x 7.2cm (2-3/8" x 2-7/8")This layer is placed toward the top, with the upper left corner near the left side of the card and the upper right corner tilted until it nearly touches the largest layer at the top.
- Third Layer, 6.5cm x 7cm (2-7/8" x 2-5/8") This layer is placed toward the bottom of the card, with the bottom left corner placed a little over a centimeter (1/2") away from the left side of the first layer and tilted down until the bottom right corner is nearly touching the edge of bottom layer.
- Fourth Layer, 10cm x 3.5 (4" x 1-3/8") The bottom edge of this strip is placed just a little lower than dead center of the card.
- Fifth Layer, Cut from Pebbled Path card stock 11.8cm x 6.3cm (2-1/2" x 4-1/2"). Cut a piece of basic white card stock to layer on top, 11.3cm x 5.8cm (2-1/4" x 4-1/4"). Stack the two pieces together leaving a small equal border of the Pebbled Path showing all the way around. After stamping, place this layer towards the right side of the largest layer leaving equal border of a little over a centimeter (1/2") showing from the first layer top and bottom.

Directions cont.

- The border showing on the right side is at your discretion, there will be slightly more showing if you are using imperial measurements than if you are using metric measurements.
- For this example of the card sketch I stamped the leaf image from the Stippled Roses on the white card stock of layer 5 along with the thank you greeting.
- I raised the greeting/ 5th layer up on Stampin Dimensionals and decorated the card further with the 2023-25 In Color Dots
- Note: Apologies for using a discontinued stamp set. This was a favorite greeting set of mine until it was discontinued summer of last year. I had placed it back on the wrong shelf and inadvertently grabbed it for use on this card. The Go To Greetings Cling Stamp Set would have worked well here in size and design and is still in stock.
