

## Stippled Roses

#### Supplies

- Stippled Roses Cling Stamp Set
- Softly Stippled Designer Series Paper
- Textured 12" x x12" Shimmer Paper
- Pebbled Path Card Stock
- Pebbled Path Stampin Pad
- Basic White Cardstock, optional card liner



- 2023-25 In Color Dots
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer

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### Stippled Roses

#### Directions

- Cut a side opening card base from the Pebbled Path card stock, 14.85cm x 21cm (5-1/2" x 8-1/2"). Score at the center, 10.5cm (4-1/4"), fold and burnish.
- Cut two pieces of Softly Stippled Designer Series Paper to 10cm x 4.5cm (4" x 1-7/8"). Glue to the top and bottom of the card front as shown in the photograph.
- Cut another piece of 10cm x 4.5cm (4" x 1-7/8") from a second pattern piece of the Softly Stippled Designer Series Paper. Glue this piece to the card front between the first two pieces of patterned paper.
- The size of the center piece depends on the size of the image you use. I recommend stamping your large image first and then cutting it down. If you are using the Stippled Roses stamp set, you will cut your Textured Shimmer paper to approximately 8.3cm x 11.8cm (3-1/4" x 4-5/8").
- Stamp the large rose image onto the center of the Textured Shimmer paper using the Pebbled Path Stampin ink.
- Place the In Color dots as shown in the photo & card sketch.
- Glue the main image to the center of the card with an almost equal border on all sides. I have raised mine up on Stampin Dimensionals but this is optional.
- Optional: Cut a card liner of Basic White 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Decorate and glue to the inside of the card.

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
