




April Card Sketch

Supplies

- Circle Sayings Stamp Set
- Berry Burst Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Wonderfully Made Designer
 Series Paper
- Gorgeous Gingham Designer
 Series Paper
- Berry Burst Stampin Pad
- 2-3/8" Circle Punch

- Tinsel Gems Four Pack
- Paper Trimmer
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2"). Score halfway at 10.5cm (4-1/4")
- The first layer cut from your Designer Series Paper is 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4"). This piece is glued down to the card front leaving an equal border all the way around.
- Optional: Cut a card liner out of basic white, 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- The 'mock ribbon' rectangle is cut from Gorgeous Gingham Designer Series Paper is approximately 4cm x 13.5cm (1-1/2" x 5"). To cut the sparrow tail, make a mark halfway of the width of the ribbon' 2cm (3/4") at the bottom of the strip. Next move your pencil up and mark again 2cm (3/4") from the bottom. Clip along these two marks, then clip from each of the outside points into the middle. This will give you an even tail. (see drawing next page).
- The Designer Series Papers used in this sample is quite busy. I wanted to make the 'mock ribbon' stand out a little more and calm 'the busy' a little bit. To do this I cut an additional piece of Berry Burst card stock a little larger than than the Gorgeous Gingham piece: 4.5cm x 14cm (1-3/4" x 5-1/4"). I used the same technique to cut the tail and then layered the the Gingham piece over the top.
- The square layer is cut from the same piece of Gorgeous Gingham and is approximately 6cm x 10cm (3" x 4"). The opposite side of the paper was used for this element.
- The greeting and image were stamped onto a piece of basic white card stock using Berry Burst ink. I used the matching 2-3/4" circle punch to cut it out.

Directions cont.

• Assemble the card as in the photograph. The circle is popped up on dimensionals. The card was finished with three of the Tinsel Gems from the Tinsel Gems Four Pack
