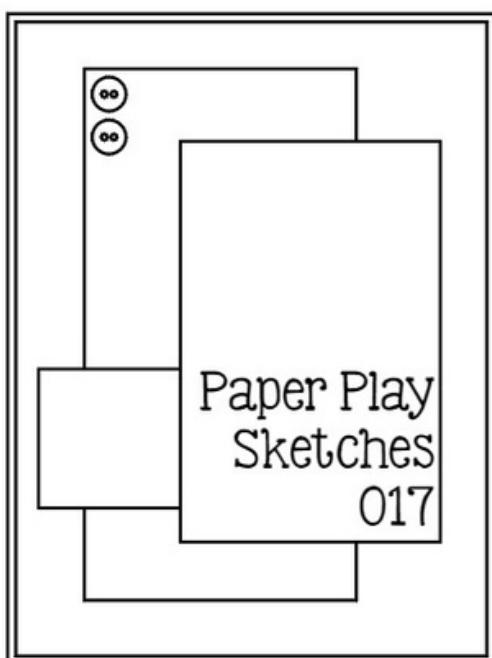

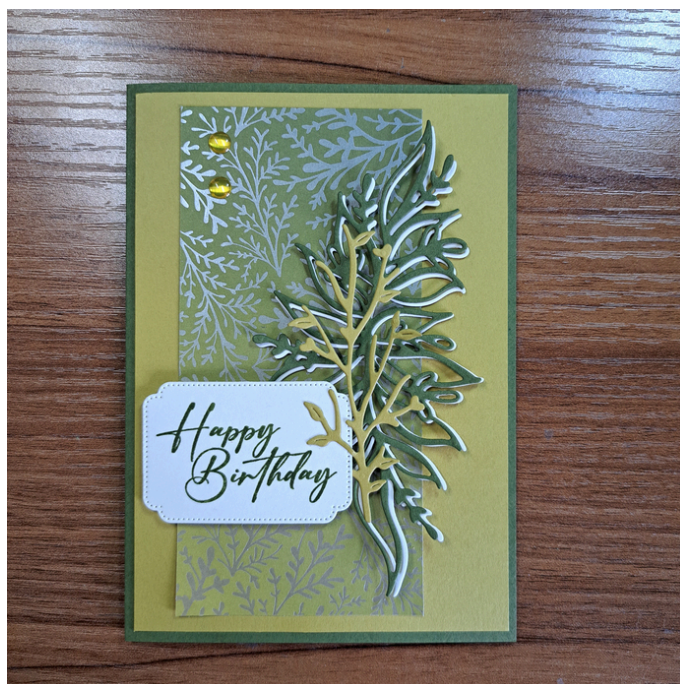

Supplies

- Thoughtful Wishes Die Set
- Unbound Love Stamp Set
- Unbound Love Die Set
- Mossy Meadow Card Stock
- Wild Wheat Card Stock
- Very Vanilla Card Stock
- Thoughtful Designs Designer Series Paper
- Mossy Meadow Stampin Pad
- 2023-2024 In Color Dots
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut & Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2"). Score halfway at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). For this example I used Mossy Meadow card stock.
- The first layer cut from Wild Wheat Card Stock and is 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4"). This piece is glued down to the card front leaving an equal border all the way around.
- Optional: Cut a card liner out of very vanilla, 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- The next layer is cut from Thoughtful Designs Designer Series Paper and measures 6.4cm x 13.5cm (2-1/2" x 5").
- Instead of a smaller rectangle measuring 5cm x 11.5cm (2" x 4-1/8"), I die cut 4 elements that occupy the same space. One of the larger components from cut from the Mossy Meadow is layered over a second one cut from the Very Vanilla. The Mossy Meadow element is off set so that the vanilla shows just to the right. A Third and slightly smaller component is cut from the Wild Wheat. Part of this one is glued to the greeting.
- The greeting is stamped with Mossy Meadow ink onto a small rectangle of Vanilla and die cut using a die from the Unbound Love Die set.
- After adhering the Wild Wheat die cut element onto the greeting, place Stampin Dimensionals on the back to pop it.

Note: The die cut elements are quite delicate and will require a bit of care when you place the card into it's envelope.
