


Wishing Lots of Love January Card Sketch



Supplies

- Delightful Wishes
- Delightful Wishes Dies
- Spotlight on Nature Dies
- Basic White Card Stock
- Daffodil Delight Card Stock
- Lemon Lolly Card Stock
- Floral Delight Designer Series Paper
- Floral & Gingham Vellum
- Lemon Lolly Stampin' Pad
- Daffodil Delight Stampin' Pad
- Tiny Bee Trinkets
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Mini Glue Dots
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Basic White card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- For the optional card 'liner' cut a piece of basic white card stock 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4"). I did not need a liner in this case as my card base is white.
- I have reversed layer one and layer two for this card, for this example cut a near square from Lemon Lolly Card Stock, 9.5cm x 9cm (4" x 4-1/8"). Place this piece just a little higher than centered onto the card front. (See finished photo)
- For the next layer cut a piece of Floral & Gingham Vellum Designer Series Paper, measuring 8.5cm x 12.85cm (3-3/8" x 5-1/8"). At the bottom of the rectangle (short side) mark the half way point, 4.25 (1-11/16"). Now from that mark, measure up 2cm (3/8"). From this point draw a diagonal line down to the right corner and another down to the left corner. Cut on these line to create the 'banner' shape. Center on the card over the Lemon Lolly square (see finished photo).
- Using the 8.5cm (3-1/4") circle from the Spotlight On Nature Dies from basic white card stock.
- Stamp the base color of the small flowers with the Lemon Lolly ink and over stamp with the highlight stamp and Daffodil Delight ink.
- Die cut the word 'wishing' from a scrap of the Daffodil Delight card stock and the outline of the word 'wishing' from a scrap of Lemon Lolly. Glue the the two pieces together.
- Die cut the strip from a scrap of Basic White card stock. Optionally you can just cut a strip. Stamp the second half of your greeting onto this white piece and trim to fit.
- Glue both word pieces to the stamped circle at the bottom. See finished photo for placement.
- Using glue dots place three of the tiny bee trinkets to finish.
- Use dimensionals, applied to the back of the circle piece, to pop it up.
