Supplies

- Thoughtful Moments Hybrid Embossing Folder
- Timber 3-D Embossing Folder
- Deckled Circles Dies
- Basic Beige Card Stock
- Basic Gray Card Stock
- Gray Granite Card Stock
- Country Woods Designer Series Paper
- Gray Granite Stampin' Pad
- Basic Beige Stampin' Pad
- Linen Thread
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Mini Stampin Dimensionals
- Blending Brush
- Stampin Brayer
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut & Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the basic gray card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- For the first layer cut a piece of Gray Granite card stock, measuring 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Using the brayer and Gray Granite ink, apply ink to the facing side (the side with the Stampin Up logo) of the Timber 3-D embossing folder. Add the piece of card stock and emboss as usual. Glue the embossed piece to the the front of the card base leaving an equal border on all sides. See finished photo.
- For the optional card 'liner' cut a piece of basic beige card stock 10cm x 14.4cm (4" x 5-1/4"). A card liner is not required for this card.
- Layer number two is cut from the basic gray card stock, 7.5cm x 8.5cm (3" x 3-5/8"). Place this piece just a little higher than centered onto the card front. (See finished photo)
- Layer number three is a long rectangle cut from the Country Wood Designer Series Paper set, 5.5cm x 11.5cm (2-3/8" x 4-1/2"). Glue directly to the center of the Shaded Spruce layer.
- Using a circle die sized approximately 7cm (2-3/4") cut out a circle from Basic Beige. *An appropriate sized punch can also be used. Brush the edges with a blending brush and some basic beige ink.
- Ink the brayer with Gray Granite and roll over the facing side of the Thoughtful Moments Hybrid embossing folder. Place the cutting piece down onto the folder and then add some gray granite card stock. Run through your embossing machine. Most any of these greetings will work on this card I chose the Thank You sentiment.
- Use mini dimensionals, applied to the back of the sentiment piece, to pop the sentiment up on the circle. Before placing down I looped a length of the Linen thread behind the sentiment to add more texture.
- I left the inside blank for this card.
