


Supplies

- Mixed Labels Stamp Set
- Sending Love Die Set
- Take to the Sky Designer Series Paper
- Boho Blue Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Boho Blue Stampin Pad
- 2023-2025 In Color Sparkle Dots
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Mini Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Mini Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Boho Blue card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- For the First Layer cut a piece of Take to the Sky Designer Series Paper, measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2). Attach to the front of the card leaving an equal border of the card stock showing all the way around.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2).
- Layer number two is cut from Boho Blue card stock and measures 10.5cm x 5.5cm (4" x 2"). Glue this layer flat to the first layer, see the finished photo for placement.
- Using the mini envelope die from the Sending Love die set cut three envelopes from scraps of white card stock. Adhere all three of them closed by putting glue only on the 'point' of the outside flap. This will make the envelope more three-dimensional.
- Decorate the envelopes by placing a Boho Blue sparkle dot at the outside point of the mini envelope flaps.
- Adhere the mini envelopes to the Boho Blue strip across the front of the card, see finished photo for placement.
- For the greeting cut a strip of white card stock 7cm x 1cm. Using the Boho Blue ink stamp the words 'Just A Note' from the Mixed Labels stamp set.
- Place mini dimensionals on the back of the greeting and affix to the card as shown in the finished photo.
