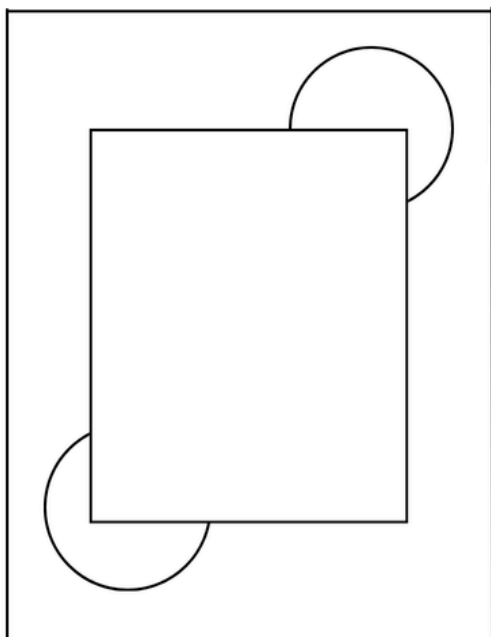

Supplies

- Thoughtful Moments Hybrid Embossing Folder
- Spotlight on Nature Die Set
- Petunia Pop Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- 2024-2026 In Color Designer Series Paper
- Petunia Pop Stampin Pad
- Petunia Pop 3/8" Bordered Ribbon
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Mini Glue Dots
- Mini Stampin and Regular Dimensionals
- Stampin Brayer
- Paper Trimmer
- Mini Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Petunia Pop card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2).
- For the first layer cut a piece of the 2024-2026 In Color Designer Series Paper to 10cm x 14.35 (4" x 5-1/4").
- The second layer consists of two circles cut from Petunia Pop card stock using one of the 5.5cm (") circles from the Spotlight on Nature die set.
- The intention is to make these circles a little larger than the previous card sketch examples to demonstrate variation. However, these circles may be a little too large if you are working in imperial measure. If the balance of the card feels a little odd, drop back and cut your circles a bit smaller using a 1-3/4" (4.5cm) punch or the size smaller in the die set which is also 1-3/4" (4.5cm). If you do not own the spotlight on Nature die set I can recommend the Stylish Shapes die set. (This set has all the basic circle and rectangle sizes)
- Place dimensionals on the back of the circles and place them on the card as shown in the finished photo.
- For the top layer of the card, cut a piece of 2024-2026 In Color Designer Series Paper, measuring 7.3cm x 10cm (2-7/8" x 3-15-16").
- Wrap a piece of the Petunia Pop ribbon around the front of the the paper layer and secure on the back. If you are good at tying bows tie one onto the ribbon (or in my case tie one separately and stick it on) to the left side of the feature piece as shown in the finished photo.
- Glue the greeting to the front of the card on *top* of the circles. Placing your glue on the circles only.
- The greeting is die cut using the Thoughtful Moments hybrid die set with basic white card stock. Before cutting, I inked up the embossing folder with Petunia Pop ink using a brayer.
- Place the mini dimensionls on the back of the greeting and adhere to the top of the ribbon.
