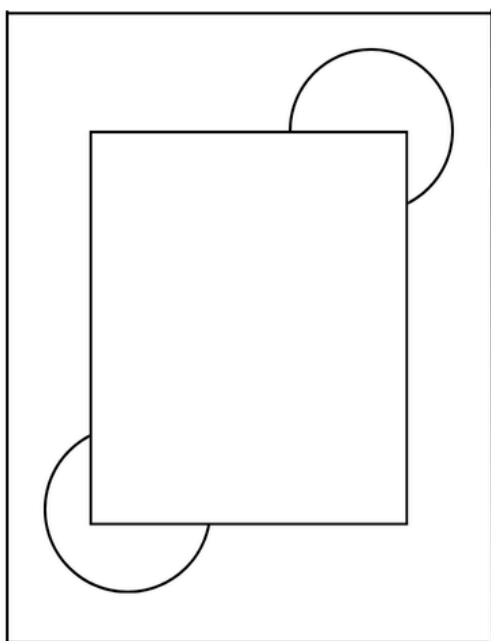


Tulips

April Card Sketch



Supplies

- Mixed Florals Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Spotlight on Nature Die Set
- Calypso Coral Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Scrap of Basic Black Card Stock-optional
- Tuxedo Black Memento Ink Pad
- Calypso Coral Stampin Pad
- Tiny Bee Trinkets
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Mini Glue Dots
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Blending Brush
- Paper Trimmer
- Mini Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Calypso Coral card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2).
- The first layer consists of two circles cut from Calypso Coral card stock using one of the 2.5cm (1") circles from the Spotlight on Nature die set. If you use the circle with the cut outs as in the photo graph cut a set of solid circles from the scrap of black card stock to stack behind the Calypso Coral Circles.
- Optional: brush small bit of Calypso Coral ink around the edges of the circles to make them stand out a little bit.
- Alternatively cut a pair of plain circles and use a black marker such as the Stampin Write Black marker and draw 'stitching lines' around the circle.
- The next layer measures 7.9cm x 11.2cm (2-7/8" x 4-3/8". This layer can either be a background piece you have created or a piece of designer series paper stamped with the tulip image from the Mixed Media Floral Photopolymer Stamp set.
- I created this background paper using the watercolor pencils from Stampin' Up and a technique I demonstrated in my blog post of April 23, 2025 entitled "How to Make an Amazing Card -on-Card", the post also includes a video.
- Place dimensionals on the back of stamped piece and place it on the card as shown in the finished photo.
- Finish decorating you card with three of the Tiny Bee Trinkets, attached with mini glue dots.
