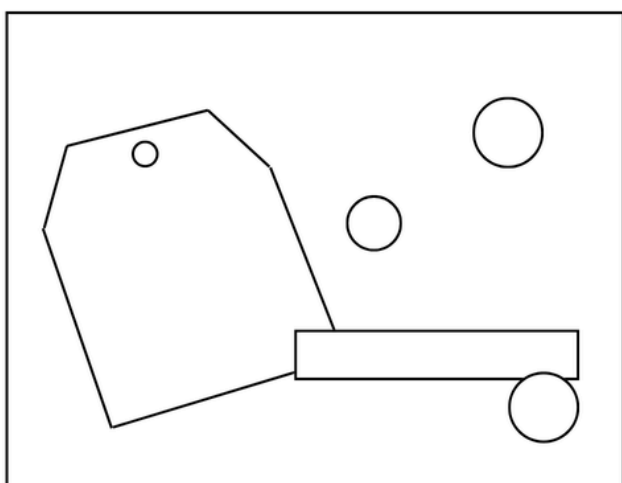


Gallery Blooms May Card Sketch

- Gallery Blooms Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Mixed Labels Die Set
- Heartfelt Hexagon Punch
- Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper
- Crumb Cake Card Stock
- Pretty Peacock Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Pretty Peacock Stampin' Pad
- Crumb Cake Stampin' Write
- Linen Thread
- Holographic Resin Dots
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Mini Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a bottom opening card base 14.85 X 21cm (5-1/2" x 8-1/2") from the Crumb Cake card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 14.35cm X 10cm (4-1/2" x 4").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of Pretty Peacock card stock to 14.35cm X 10cm (4-1/2" x 4")
- For the next layer cut a piece of the Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper to 13.85cm x 9.5cm (4-1/4" x 3-3/4").
- To make the tag trim a piece of white card stock to a strip 5cm (2") wide by approximately 8cm (3-1/4") long. Feed this strip into the back of the Heartfelt Hexagon punch so that only the top is trimmed off of the strip, this will form the top of your tag. Stamp the tag with your chosen image in Pretty Peacock ink. Use either the Crumb Cake Stampin Marker or the Crumb Cake Stampin Blend to flick bits of ink onto the tag, creating a 'fly spec' effect.
- To make the backing layer for the tag cut a piece of Pretty Peacock 5.5cm by approximately 9cm (2-1/4" x approximately 3-1/2"). As you did with the first tag layer, feed the strip into the back of the Heartfelt Hexagon and punch out the top. Adhere the white layer onto this layer leaving approximately 2 to 3cm (1/4") on the top and sides showing the Peacock color. Now trim the excess Pretty Peacock card stock off of the bottom of the tag leaving only the 2cm (1/4") of the Peacock showing. (See finished photo)
- Next, using the D-Slot hole punch included in the Tags of Thanks set, cut a small hole near the top of the tag.
- Add some Linen thread to the top of the tag to further embellish it. Adhere the tag flat to the DSP layer of the card front. Position it as shown in the finished photo.
- Die cut the line image out of a piece of scrap Pretty Peacock and another one out of a scrap of the Crumb Cake. Adhere these two pieces together so that the Crumb Cake piece is offset slightly higher and to the right of the Peacock piece. Adhere this piece to the card front in the position shown in the finished photo.
- Finish by placing the holographic resin dots as shown.
