

Supplies

- Delightful Wishes Stamp Set
- Delightful Wishes Dies
- Heartfelt Hexagonal Punch
- Tags of Thanks Punch
- Floral Delights Designer
 Series Paper
- Basic White Card Stock
- Balmy Blue Card Stock
- Balmy Blue Stampin' Pad

- Iridescent Striped Trim
- Adhesive Sheet
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Mini Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Snips Scissors
- Paper Trimmer
- Mini Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a bottom opening card base 14.85 X 21cm (5-1/2" x 8-1/2") from the basic white card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 14.35cm X 10cm (4-1/2" x 4"). I find that this is not needed for this card as the base is white.
- For the first layer cut a piece of the Balmy Blue card stock to 14.35cm X 10cm (4-1/2" x 4") to act as a back ground.
- For the next layer cut a piece of the Floral Delights Designer Series Paper to 13.85cm x 9.5cm (4-1/4" x 3-3/4").
- To make the tag trim a piece of designer series paper to a strip 5cm (2") wide by approximately 8cm (3-1/4") long. Feed this strip into the back of the Heartfelt Hexagon punch so that only the top is trimmed off of the strip, this will form the top of your tag. Next, using the D-Slot hole punch included in the Tags of Thanks set, cut a small hole near the top of the tag.
- Cut a piece of the Iridescent trim and feed through the slot on the tag, looping it on itself as shown in the photo.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the tag and place on the card as shown in the finished photo.
- Die cut the background of the 'wishing' greeting and the long 'tab' piece from basic white card stock.
- Adhere a small piece of double sided adhesive sheet, the size of your greeting, to the back of a piece of Balmy Blue card stock. Cut the thin coordinating 'wishing' greeting out. Having the double sided adhesive will really help you when attaching the blue lettering to it's coordinating back ground.
- Cut a couple of mini dimensionals in half and affix to the right side of the back of the greeting. Place glue on the left side and glue the greeting piece to the tag and the card base. See the finished photo for placement detail.
- Stamp the 'long tab' with the second part of the greeting using Balmy Blue ink. Place a dimensional on the right side of the back of the tab and glue on the left side. Glue to the tag and card base just underneath the Wishing part of your greeting.
- Fussy cut out three flowers of varying shapes from the same dsp used for the tag. Place a dimensional on the back of each one and affix to the card as shown in the finished photo.
