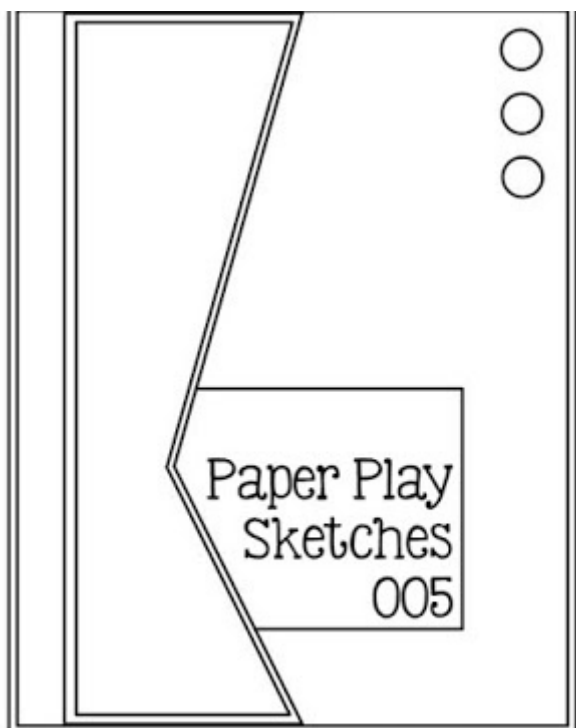

Supplies

- Notes & Totes Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper
- Crumb Cake Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Gorgeous Grape Stampin' Pad
- Purple Fine Shimmer Gems
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Crumb Cake card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper to act as a back ground to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the next layer cut a rectangle from a piece of the Crumb Cake card stock 4cm x 14.35cm (1-3/4" x 5-1/4").
- Cut another rectangle out of the Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper 5 cm (1/4") smaller, top and right. So this rectangle measures 3.5cm x 13.85cm (1-1/2" x 5")
- To find where to put the notch in the rectangle: place the rectangle down with the narrow end at the top; measure over half way (2cm or 7/8") make a small mark here with a pencil. Place your ruler at this mark and measure down 10cm (3-1/2") and place another mark.
- Erase your mark at the top as it is no longer needed.
- Cut on the diagonal down from the top right corner of your card stock/paper down to the 10cm (3-1/2") mark. Now cut up from the bottom right corner to the same mark and remove the extra paper.
- To cut the notch on the Designer Series Paper rectangle, tape the rectangle to the crumb cake base rectangle leaving equal amount of crumb cake showing on the top and bottom and leaving 5cm (1/4") showing on the left side. Turn the piece over and trace the crumb cake notch onto the DSP. Remove the DSP and the tape and cut on the lines you have just drawn. See diagram on pg. 3
- Layer the notched DSP rectangle over the larger card stock notched rectangle leaving an equal border all the way around.
- Place dimensionals on the back of this notched rectangle piece being sure to leave the area where your greeting go blank. Stick this piece to the card base as shown in the finished photo.
- For the greeting, cut a rectangle from the Crumb Cake card stock to 7.5cm x 4cm (3" x 1-1/2") to act as a matting layer for your greeting.
- Cut another rectangle from basic white card stock 7cm x 3.5cm (2-3/4" x 1-1/4"). Stamp your greeting in Gorgeous Grape ink using the sentiment from the Notes & Totes stamp set.

Directions cont.

- Adhere the greeting piece to the Crumb Cake backing and place on your card as shown in the finished photo, tucking one side underneath your notched rectangle.
- Finish the card using the Purple Fine Shimmer Gems as shown on finished card.
