

Supplies

- Tags of Thanks Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Gallery Blooms Die Set
- Damask Designs Embossing Folder
- Beautiful Gallery Designer
 Series Paper
- Gray Granite Card Stock
- Basic Beige Card Stock
- Gray Granite Stampin' Pad

- Basic Beige Ribbon
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Blending Brush
- Paper Trimmer
- Mini Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Gray Granite card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic beige card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper to act as a back ground to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the next layer cut a rectangle from a piece of the basic beige card stock to 4.5cm x 10.85cm (2-1/4" x 4").
- Place the beige rectangle in the Damask Designs Embossing folder and emboss. Lightly go over the design with a bit of the baisc gray ink on a blending brush.
- Adhere the rectangle piece to the card front positioned as shown in the finished photo.
- Die cut the small flowers from the Gallery Blooms die set out of the basic gray card stock. Stick the stems of three of the flowers together.
- Tie a small bow out of the basic beige ribbon. Adhere the ribbon to the stems of the gray die cut flowers and adhere to the top of the embossed rectangle.
- Cut the greeting strip from a piece of basic beige card stock, 7.7cm x 3.2cm (3" x 1-1/4"). Stamp the greeting using the grey granite ink. Affix the last of the small die cut flowers to the right side of the greeting strip.
- Cut a backing piece for the greeting strip from a piece of the basic gray card stock, 8.2cm x 3.7cm (3-1/4" x 1-1/2"). Glue the two rectangles together leaving a small border of the gray showing on all sides.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting strip and adhere to the card as shown in the finished photo.
