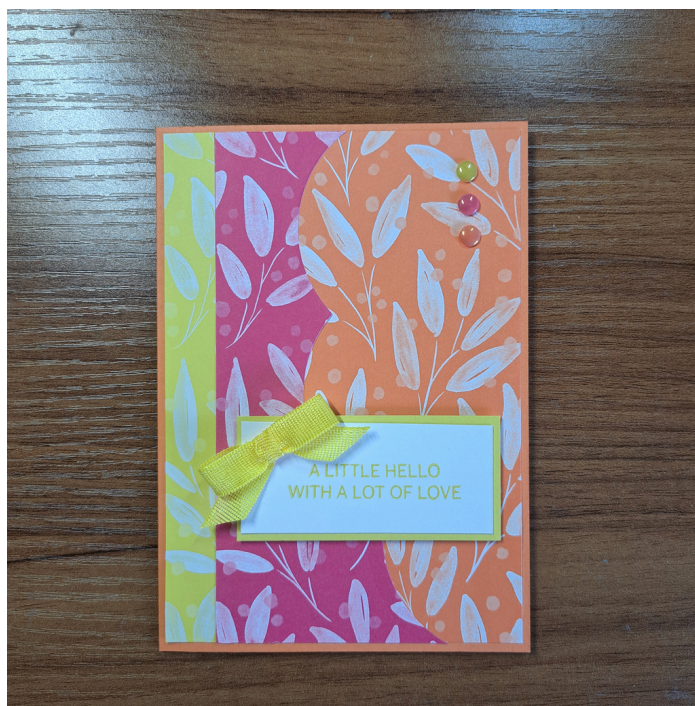
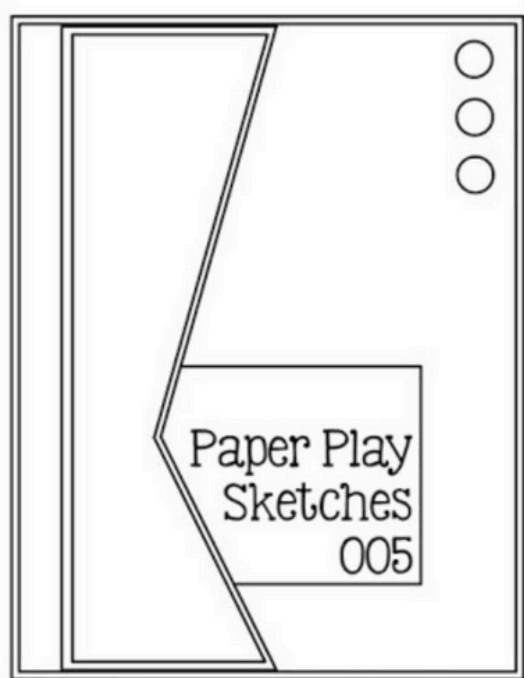

## A Little Hello July Card Sketch



### Supplies

- Fancy Borders Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Fancy Borders Die Set
- 2025-2027 In Color Designer Series Paper
- Timid Tiger Card Stock
- Darling Duckling Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Darling Duckling Stampin Pad
- Darling Duckling Faux Linen Ribbon
- 2025-2027 In Color Flat Pearls
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Mini Cut and Emboss Machine

**Directions**

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 ( 8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Timid Tiger card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Timid Tiger color of the 2025-2027 In Color Designer Series Paper to act as a back ground to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2"). Adhere this piece to the card front leaving a small equal border of the card stock showing all the way around.
- For the next layer cut a thin rectangle from a Darling Duckling piece of the 2025-2027 In Color Designer Series Paper 1.5cm x 14.35cm (5/8" x 5-1/4"). Glue this piece on top of the first layer matching the top, bottom and left sides.
- Cut a third rectangle out of the Strawberry Slush 2025-2027 In Color Designer Series Paper approximately 6cm x 14.35 (2-3/8 x 4-1/2"). Trim off the right side of the rectangle using the triple curved die from the Fancy Borders die set. Adhere this piece flush up against the Darling Duckling rectangle, on top of the Timid Tiger back ground.
- Cut another rectangle from a scrap of basic white card stock for the greeting, 7cm x 3cm (2-3/4" x 1-1/4). I used a greeting from the Fancy Borders set and stamped it in Darling Duckling ink.
- An additional rectangle was cut from the Darling Duckling card stock, 7.5cm x 3.5cm (3" x 1-1/2") to act as a mating layer for the greeting. This piece is glued to the back of the greeting leaving a small border showing all the way around the greeting piece.
- A small bow tied with the Darling Duckling ribbon was added to the top corner of the greeting piece with a mini glue dot.
- The greeting is raised up on dimensionals and placed as shown in the finished photo.
- The final step is to place a trio of the 2025-2027 In Color Flat Pearls in the upper right corner of the card front. I choose to use one of each color used in the card but I did try using three of only one color and it looked nice as well.
