

Supplies

- Tags to Go Cling Stamp Set
- Tags to Go Dies
- Floral Delights Designer Series Paper
- Peach Pie Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Peach Pie Stampin' Pad
- 2024-26 In Color Flat Pearls
- Peach Pie 3/8" Ribbon
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Mini Glue Dots
- Paper Trimmer
- Mini Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Peach Pie card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Floral Delights Designer Series Paper to act as a back ground to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the next layer cut a rectangle from a piece of the Peach Pie card stock 4cm x 14.35cm (1-3/4" x 5-1/4").
- Cut another rectangle out of the Floral Delights Designer Series Paper to 3.5cm x 13.85cm (1-1/2" x 5")
- Cut each rectangle from the bottom right corner up to the top left corner diagonally.
- Layer the 'bottom' triangle of Designer Series Paper over the 'bottom' peach pie card stock triangle leaving approximately 2cm or 1/8" all of the way around.
- Turn the 'top' rectangles over to the back sides. Layer the back side of the Designer Series Paper 'top' triangle over the back side 'top' of the Peach Pie card stock triangle.
- Place the 'top' decorated rectangle on your work surface. Place the 'bottom' rectangle on the top of the 'top' aligning the left sides. Glue these pieces together. (See finished photo)
- Adhere this new piece to the card front as shown in the finished photo. Note, I only put glue on the top and bottom areas of this piece so that I could slide my greeting under the edge.
- Die cut the tag shape from a scrap of white card stock and stamp your greeting with Peach Pie ink. I used one of the tags from the Tags to Go die set and a greeting from the Tags to Go stamp set.
- To further decorate the tag I glued a scrap of the designer series paper to the right side of the tag. Which was then glued down with the edge tucked under the triangle shape piece.
- Final touches included a tiny bow tied from the Peach Pie ribbon and flat pearls from the 2024-2026 In Color Flat Pearls embellishments.
