

Supplies

- Tags of Thanks Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Mini Corrugated 3D Embossing Folder
- Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper
- Mossy Meadow Card Stock
- Pecan Pie Card Stock
- Basic Beige Card Stock
- Mossy Meadow Stampin' Pad

- Pecan Pie Stampin' Pad
- Linen Thread
- Pressed Flower Motifs
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Blending Brush
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

• Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Mossy Meadow card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.

- Optionally cut a card liner from basic beige card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Gallery Blooms Designer Series Paper to act as a back ground to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the next layer cut a rectangle from a coordinating piece of the Gallery Blooms Designer Series Paper 6cm x 14.85cm (2-1/4" x 5-1/2").
- Tear this rectangle in the 'K' shape shown in the card sketch. If you
 like the white core showing as I did, tear the paper towards you. If you
 prefer to not have the white edge (as shown on the top and bottom of
 the 'K' in the finished photo) tear the paper away from you.
- Using a blending brush and the Pecan Pie ink, brush the ink onto the raw edges of the 'K' on all sides. The ink gave the piece a slightly more distressed worn look and muted the stark white edges.
- Wrap a piece of linen thread loosely around the smallest part of the 'K' shape and leave the ends long. Glue this 'K' piece flat to the card front, the tails of the thread should hang free to be able to tie the greeting on in the next steps.
- To create your greeting cut a piece of Pecan Pie card stock to approximately 6cm x 4.5cm (2-3/8" x 1-3/4"). Stamp the greeting with Mossy Meadow ink. Place this piece in the Mini Corrugated 3D Embossing folder and put through your Cut and Emboss machine. *Please note this 3D folder is too big to fit through the Mini Cut and Emboss machine.
- Brush Pecan Pie ink onto the corrugated ridges and the corners of the greeting piece.
- Punch a hole in the upper left corner of the greeting. I used a ancient 6cm (1/4") hole punch I bought from an office supply store many years ago.
- Tie the tag to the card front using the loose tails of the Linen Thread. I
 tied a knot first and then added a bow. One side of the bow was pulled
 free so there was only one loop.
- Finish the card using the Pressed Flower Motifs as shown in finished photo. I realized I got the top two Motifs a little too close together but they were stuck down fast so no making any corrections there. LOL
