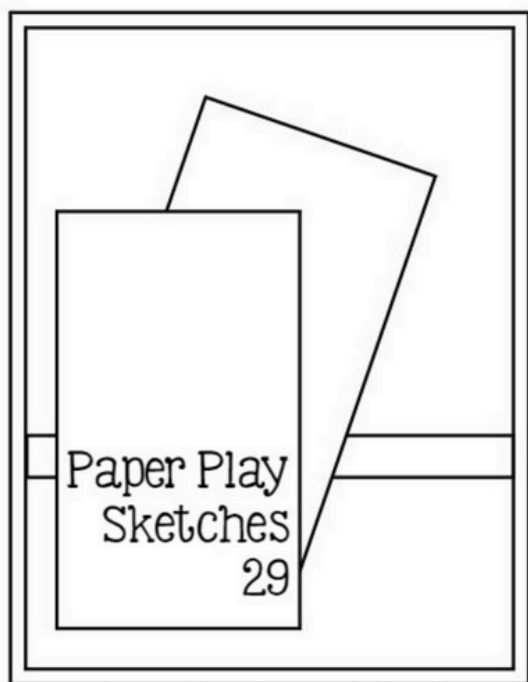


## Thank You August Card Sketch

### Supplies

- Textured Notes Stamp Set
- Everyday Arches Die Set
- Botanical Textures Designer Series Paper
- Basic Black Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Tuxedo Black Memento Stampin Pad
- Neutral Matte Dots
- Petal Pink & White 1/4" Diagonal Trim
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Mini Glue Dots
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

## Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 ( 8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the basic black card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well. If you prefer something a little different this card would work well with a bottom opening card. In which case your half sheet of card stock would measure 10.5cm x 29.7cm (4-1/4" x 11"). Score half way on the long side at 14.84cm (5-1/2")
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 4-1/2").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Botanical Textures Designer Series Paper to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Glue to top half of this piece to the top half of your card leaving an equal border of the black showing on all sides
- Cut a length of the white ribbon and wrap it around the Botanical Texture piece. So the card did not appear lumpy, I wrapped the piece all the way around the back and with a mini glue dot, secured it to **it's self** on the front (so that you can slide the greeting underneath). Tie a bow from another piece of the ribbon and secure it over the top of the wrapped ribbon to hide the the overlap seam of the ribbon. See finished photo for placement
- For the second layer, cut an arch using a coordinating piece of the Botanical Textures DSP and the 6cm x 9cm (2-1/4" x 3-1/2") size arch from the Everyday Arches die set. .
- The third layer is a arch cut from a scrap of basic white card stock. Again using the same 6cm x 9cm (2-1/4" x 3-1/2") arch die used in layer number two. Stamp the greeting and the foliage motif onto this piece using the Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Optionally flick some tiny dots onto the greeting piece using a dark black Stampin Blend marker.
- Attach the two arches together, I used a piece of cello tape on the back. Place adhesive on the back of the combined pieces and slide it under the ribbon to glue flat to the card front.
- Finish by adding a some Neutral Matte Dots .
