

## Thank You September Card Sketch

## **Supplies**

- Tags of Thanks Stamp Set
- Perfectly Pears dies
- Textured Notes Dies
- Painterly Pears Designer Series
  Paper
- Mossy Meadow Card Stock
- Smoky Slate Card Stock

- Mossy Meadow Stampin' Pad
- Low Profile Sparkle Dots
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

## **Directions**

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Mossy Meadow card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well. If you prefer something a little different this card would work well with a bottom opening card. In which case your half sheet of card stock would measure 10.5cm x 29.7cm (4-1/4" x 11"). Score half way on the long side at 14.84cm (5-1/2")
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from basic beige card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Place the rectangle back into your paper cutter with the long side at the top and cut at 4cm (1-1/2") so you have a strip that is 10cm x 4cm (4"x 1-1/2"). Now slide your paper through a little more to the 2.5cm (1") mark and cut another strip. You should now have three rectangles: 10cm x 4cm, 10cm x 2.5cm, and 10cm x 7.85 (4" x 1-1/2", 4" x 1", and 4" x 2-3/4")
- Glue the 10cm x 4cm (4"x 1-1/2") rectangle to the upper portion of your card front leaving an equal border of card stock showing on the top and the right and left sides. Flip the 2.5cm (1") piece over and use the reverse side to glue next to the top rectangle. The last rectangle will butt up next to the first two and there should be an equal border of card stock showing to the right, left and bottom. See finished photo.
- Using a piece of Smoky Slate card stock, die cut a large rectangle using the 7.2cm x 11cm (2-7/8" x 4-3/8") size rectangle from the Textured Notes die set. Stamp your greeting using Mossy Meadow ink. I used a textured dots stamp to create some interest on the Slate rectangle. After looking at it I think I should have used a Mossy Meadow marker and flicked some ink spots over the rectangle instead. Glue this piece to the card front positioned as shown in the finished photo.
- Find the piece of the DSP that coordinates with the Perfectly Pear large pear and large stem/leaf die. Die cut a pear and stem/leaf from this paper. Place dimensionals on the pear and leaves and adhere to the Smoky Slate Rectangle. See finished photo for placement.
- Finish the card with some of the Low Profile Sparkle Dots.
