

## Cutting out your Designer Series Papers October Card Sketch No. 3

This card sketch compliments of the Stampin'Up! design team from The September-December 2025 Mini Catalogue

### **Supplies**

- Delightful Motifs Stamp Set
- Damask Designs Embossing Folder
- Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper
- Basic Beige Card Stock
- Soft Seafoam Card Stock
- Garden Green Stampin Pad

- Flower Motifs (Embellishments)
- Linen Thread
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Snips/scissors
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut & Emboss Machine

#### **Directions**

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Basic Beige card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from basic beige card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Even though you can easily write on the basic beige I still use liner to increase the weight of the card and to make an opportunity to stamp on the inside.
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Soft Seafoam card stock to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Using the Damask Designs embossing folder emboss the entire piece and adhere to the front of the card leaving an equal border of the card base showing all the way around.
- Fussy cut the flowers out of the Designer Series Paper. You will have to cut the motif into parts; not all parts will be used.
- Cut a rectangular label from the basic beige card stock to approximately 9cm x 3cm (3-1/2"x 1-1/4"). Stamp the sentiment to one side in Garden Green ink. Distress the edges of the label by running your scissors over the edges. Tie a piece of linen thread around the tag and make a bow at the bottom as shown in the finished photo.
- Adhere the label to the fussy cut pieces as shown in the finished photo. Place dimensionals on the back side of these two pieces treating them as one object and glue to the card front.
- Finish the card with some of the Floral Motifs embellishments.
