


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World Card Making Day November Card Sketch No. 2

Template No.2 from the World Card Making Day Craft A Long October 2025





Supplies

- Beautiful Motifs Stamp Set
- Stylish Shapes Dies
- 2025-2027 In Color Designer Series Paper
- Strawberry Slush Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Strawberry Slush Stampin Pad
- Pecan Pie Stampin Pad

- Faux Linen Ribbon 3/8"
- 2025-2027 In Color Flat Pearls
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut & Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Strawberry Slush card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the 2025-2027 In Color Designer Designer Series Paper to 10cm x 7.6cm (4" x 3"). For the Second Layer cut a second piece using a coordinating paper from the same set. This will be the 'background'.
- Die cut the first layer using the Stylish Shapes dies. The 7cm (2-3/4") circle was used to cut the top left and the bottom right holes. I used the 6cm (2-3/8" circle for the top right cut out. And the largest circle 7.5cm (3") for the bottom left.
- After you have cut your circles glue this piece to the coordinating 'background' piece. Be sure all of the straight edges are lined up.
- Place the 2nd to smallest flagged rectangle in the place you want your greeting to go on the first/second layer. Die cut the rectangle, you want it to cut through both pieces of paper. (I ran my through the rollers twice to be sure it was well cut.) You can check the finished photo if you are uncertain on greeting placement.
- Adhere the layer to the card base leaving an equal border of card stock on top and bottom and from side to side.
- Die cut the label from basic white card stock using the smallest flagged rectangle. Stamp the greeting with the Strawberry Slush ink.
- Make a loop with a short piece of ribbon and adhere it to the center of the flagged rectangle cut out shape.
- Place dimensionals on the back side of the label and glue to the card front in the label shaped cut out on top of the ribbon.
- Finish the card by placing the Strawberry Slush flat pearls.
