Supplies

- Christmas Greenery Dies
- Peace on Earth Stamp Set
- Peace on Earth Dies
- Traditions of Christmas Designer Series Paper
- Mossy Meadow Card Stock
- Old Olive Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Mossy Meadow Stampin Pad
- Old Olive Stampin Pad
- Mossy Meadow & Gold Trim
- Low-profile Sparke Dots
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Mossy Meadow card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- For the First Layer cut a piece of the Traditions of Christmas Designer Series Paper to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere this piece to the card base leaving an equal border of card stock on on all sides.
- The second layer is a pair pine boughs die cut from Old Olive card stock using the Christmas Greenery dies. After cutting the dies gently brush some Old Olive ink down the center of the pine bough. The edges were gently curved up with a bone folder. Glue the boughs to the card over lapping them as the rectangles are overlapped in the card sketch.
- The greeting is die cut from a scrap of basic white card stock using the smaller one of the label dies from the Peace on Earth. The words are stamped in Mossy Meadow ink. Cut the larger label from the set out of Mossy Meadow card stock. Glue the white stamped label over the Mossy Meadow one leaving an equal border of the Mossy Meadow showing all around the white stamped piece.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting piece and adhere to the card stock over the pine boughs.
- Tie a bow from a piece of the Mossy Meadow & Gold Trim and affix to the top of the label with a glue dot.
- Finish the card by placing a few of the Low-profile Sparke Dots on the card front.
