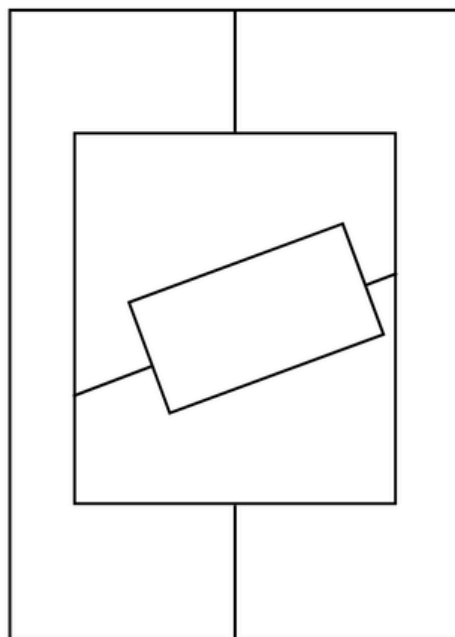


World Card Making Day December Card Sketch No. 3

Supplies

- Peace on Earth Stamp Set
- Peaceful Garden Designer Series Paper
- Cloud Cover Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Cloud Cover Inc
- Secret Sea Stampin Pad
- 2025-2027 In Color Flat Pearls
- Faux Linen 3/8" Ribbon - Cloud Cover
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensionals
- Blending Brush
- Paper Trimmer

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Cloud Cover card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- For the First Layer cut 2 pieces of the Peaceful Garden Designer Series Paper to 5cm x 14.35cm (2" x 5-1/4"). Use two different coordinating patterns for the best effect. Turn the two strips face down on your work surface. Match them together with a long seam running down the center. In this example I butted the two pieces together and used a bit of cello tape to hold them together. I then adhered this piece to the card base leaving an equal border of card stock on top and bottom and from side to side. *Optionally you could cut each strip into 4.5cm x 14.35cm (1-3/4 x 5-1/4") and leave a gap between the two strips when you adhere them to the card base.
- The second layer is a square 7.6cm x 7.6cm (3" x 3") cut from a third pattern of the Peaceful Garden Designer Series Paper. Set this piece aside for a moment.
- Cut a strip of white card stock that fits your greeting. In this case I used a rectangle, 6.8 x 3.3 (2-5/8" x 1-1/4"). The greeting was stamped with the Secret Sea Stampin Pad. After stamping I put a small amount of the Cloud Cover ink onto a Stampin Block and then onto a blending brush. Lightly blend the ink onto the edges of the label.
- Cut a strip of the ribbon and glue or tape it to the back of the label, centering it from top to bottom, leave the long edges loose. Place the label face up in a diagonal position on second square layer. When you have it where you want it, carefully lift the label and place a bit of liquid glue or glue dot to affix the label to the second layer. Wrap the ribbon ends around the to the back side of the second layer and secure. I found a bit of Stampin Seal worked best for this but cello tape also works. You can use liquid adhesive but be prepared to wait for it to dry a bit.
- Place dimensionals on the back side of this second layer and affix to the card front.
- Finish the card by placing three of the lovely Cloud Cover Flat Pearl embellishments on the card front.
