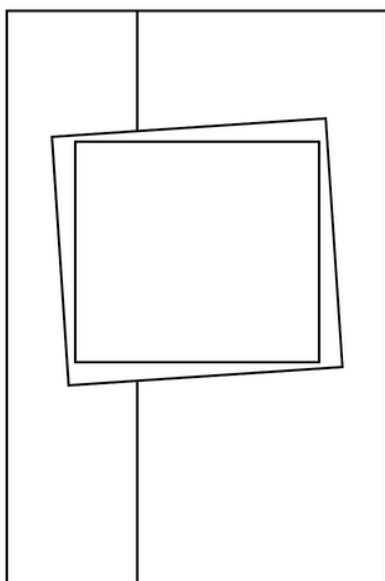

Supplies

- Elements of Text Stamp Set*
- Thoughtful Moments Hybrid Embossing Folder
- Gallery Blooms Designer Series Paper
- Smoky Slate Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Smoky Slate Stampin' Pad
- Industrial Trinkets*
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Mini Stampin' Dimensionals
- Blending Brush
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Smoky Slate card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- Cut a background piece 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4") from one of the patterns from the Gallery Blooms Designer Series Paper set.
- Split the background piece lengthwise at 3.3cm (1-1/4"). Glue the 3.3x 14.35 piece to the left side of the card front. Trim a small amount off of the larger piece so it measures approximately 6.5cm x 14.35cm (2-5/8" x 5-1/4"), glue this piece to the right front of the card leaving an equal border all the way round. See finished photograph.
- The first layer of the greeting is a 7.5 cm x 7.5cm (2-1/2" x 2-1/2") square cut from basic another piece of the Gallery Blooms Designer Series paper. I stamped the paper with the text stamp using Smoky Slate ink. You can get the same results using your computer and printer to print a text sample onto the paper. These can be easily found with Google. *The Elements of Text stamp has been discontinued.
- Rough up the edges of the paper square with a pair of scissors or your finger nail and brush some of the Smoky Slate ink around the edges to age the piece. Adhere this piece flat to the card front using the finished photo for placement reference. Do not glue down the edges, leave them rough and curling.
- Use the Hybrid Embossing folder and Die cut the 'Hello' out of a scrap of the Smoky Slate card stock. Brush more of the Smoky Slate ink over the die cut to age it.
- Put mini dimensionals on the back of the die cut and mount it in the center of the aged paper square.
- Finish the card by placing an Industrial Trinket at each corner of the square layer. *Sadly the industrial trinkets are discontinued but most any metallic or dark gray/black embellishment will work here.
