

### Supplies

- Tags of Thanks Stamp Set\*
- Perennial Postage Dies
- Square Snippets Designer Series Paper
- Darling Duckling Card Stock
- Basic Beige Card Stock
- Darling Duckling Stampin' Pad
- 3/8" Faux Linen Ribbon
- 2025-26 In Color Flat Pearls
- Masking Paper
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin Dimensions
- Blending Brush
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

## Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 ( 8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Darling Duckling card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic Beige card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- Place masking paper lengthwise 3.5cm from the folded edge\*. Using the blending brush and the Darling Duckling ink fill in the exposed 3.5cm x 14.85 section.
- The first layer is a 7.6cm x 7.6cm (3" x 3") square cut from the Square Snippets Designer Series Paper, this square is the exact size of the patterned squares on the individual sheets paper. Adhere this square as shown in the finished photo.
- The greeting is die cut using the 5cm x 5cmx ( 2" x 2") square from the Perennial Postage die set using a scrap of the Basic Beige card stock. The greeting is stamped in the Darling Duckling ink.
- Turn the sentiment piece over, drape a piece of the 3/8" faux woven ribbon, in a Z-like pattern across the back. There should be a loop and a tail protruding from opposite corners of the greeting when viewed from the front. (I found it was easier to do this if a strip or two of Stampin' Seal or double sided tape was placed down first.)
- Adhere the greeting to the card front using dimensionals. See finished photo for placement.
- Finish the card by placing three of the 2025-25 In Color Flat Pearls on the card front. Arranging them in a rough triangle.

\*Tip: I used a whole sheet of the masking paper and then just returned it to its backing paper to be used again. The mask will re-stick seamlessly.

\*Sadly the Tags of Thanks stamp set has been discontinued. I say sadly because it contains my very favorite 'Thank You' greeting.
