



Supplies

- Fabulous Sayings Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Damask Designs Embossing Folder
- Square Snippets Designer Series Paper
- Misty Moonlight Card Stock
- Cloud Cover Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Secret Sea Stampin' Pad
- 2025-27 In Color Flat Pearls
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Misty Moonlight card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut out four of the pattern squares from a piece of the Square Snippets Designer Series Paper set.
- Find the center point of the card front by lightly drawing a vertical line at 5.25cm (2-1/8") and a horizontal line at 7.4cm (2-5/8"). Use these lines to line up and adhere the squares to the card front. After the glue is dry trim off the excess DSP squares.
- For the first layer (beneath the greeting) cut a rectangle out of Cloud Cover card stock to 5.5 cm x 11cm (2-5/8" x 4-1/4") Emboss with the Damask Designs Embossing Folder. Adhere to the card front in the position shown on the card sketch.
- Using a scrap of White card stock, cut a rectangle to 4cm x 3cm (1-1/2" x 1-1/8"). Stamp the 'hello' greeting with Secret Sea ink. Adhere this in place following the card sketch.
- Create a faux ribbon by cutting a strip of Cloud Cover card stock to approximately 1cm x 10cm (3/8" x 4"). Stamp this piece with a texture stamp, for this example I used the one from Nature's Symphony.
- Glue down the faux ribbon horizontally, beginning from the left side of the card front and over lap it a little onto the hello greeting piece. Trim the strip and glue the other side opposite the 'hello' extending past the card front. Once the glue has dried trim off the excess. I used a mini T-square to help line up the faux ribbon.
- Finish with three of the Cloud Cover flat pearls from the 2025-27 In Color Collection.
