



Supplies

- Greenery Lane Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Nature Walk Designer Series Paper
- Pretty Peacock Card Stock
- Lost Lagoon
- Basic White Card Stock
- Secret Sea Stampin' Pad
- Secret Sea 3/8" Bordered Open Weave Ribbon
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Mini Stampin' Dimensionals
- Craft Knife
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Pretty Peacock card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- Cut a background piece 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4") from one of the patterns from the Nature Walk Designer Series Paper set. Lay this aside for the moment.
- For the first layer (beneath the greeting) cut a rectangle of Pretty Peacock card stock to 5.5 cm x 11cm (2-5/8" x 4-1/4") Using the Secret Sea Stampin' Pad and the smallest of the leaf images from the Greenery Lane Stamp Set, stamp the small leaf image four times. I used the new Stampin' Positioner to get the images even.
- Using a scrap of Lost Lagoon card stock, cut a rectangle to 4.5 cm x 6cm (1-3/4" x 2-3/8"). Stamp the 'love and hugs' greeting with Secret Sea ink. To make the slits for the ribbon, find the center of this piece, (2.25cm or 7/8") and make a mark about 5mm (1/4") from each edge. Using the mark as a guide cut a slit about 5mm (1/4") in length. Thread the ribbon through each slit. Pull enough ribbon through that will wrap around the card.
- Put four dimensionals (one for each corner) on the back of the greeting piece being sure to leave the ribbon free to be able to adjust it. Center the greeting piece on top of the stamped Pretty Peacock rectangle and adhere.
- Next position the greeting piece onto the Nature Walk DSP background piece as shown in the finished photo. Adhere flat with glue. Slide the ribbon through the greeting piece so that you can wrap it around the DSP and secure it to the back.
- Center this unit on the front of your card and adhere flat.
