



Supplies

- Beautiful Motifs Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Beautiful Motifs Die Set
- Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper
- Cloud Cover Card Stock
- Basic Beige Card Stock
- Cloud Cover Stampin' Write Marker
- 2025-27 In Color Flat Pearls
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Dimensionals
- Scissors
- Blending Brush
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Cloud Cover card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic Beige card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut a rectangle from a piece of the Beautiful Gallery Designer Series Paper measuring 7.5cm x 14.85cm (3" x 5-1/2"). Adhere to the center of your card front leaving an equal border of card stock showing on each side.
- Die cut the large fern shape out of a scrap Basic Beige.
- Next die cut one each of the two motif shapes from the Beautiful Motifs Die Set out of Cloud Cover card stock. You will need to trim off parts of the motifs to make them an actual cut out. (Hopefully if you look at my motifs you can tell which parts you will need to cut away). Scribble some ink from the Cloud Cover Stampin' Write Marker onto a block and use that ink and a blending brush to shade the edges of the Motif die cuts.
- Using a scrap of Cloud Cover card stock, cut a rectangle to 4.5cm x 1.9cm (1-3/4" x 3/4") this will be the backing for your greeting strip. Stamp the greeting from the Beautiful Motifs stamp set with Cloud Cover ink** onto a scrap of Basic Beige card stock. Cut the greeting to 4.2cm x 1.5cm (1-1/2" x 1/2"). Adhere the stamped piece over the Cloud Cover piece leaving a narrow border of Cloud Cover showing all the way around.
- **To apply ink to the stamp, I used my Stampin' Write marker to 'color' the stamp.
- To assemble the card, glue down the larger motif piece to the patterned paper, use the finished photo and card sketch for placement. Glue down the fern die cut over the top of the motif.
- Adhere the second, smaller die cut motif to the right of the greeting. Place a couple of dimensionals on the back of the greeting and a further couple of trimmed down mini dimensionals to die cut portion of the greeting piece. Adhere the greeting unit to the card front using the photo and sketch for placement.
- Finish with a trio of Cloud Cover Flat Pearls from the 2025-27 In Color Collection.
