



Supplies

- Greenery Lane Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Gallery Bloom Dies
- Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper
- Gorgeous Grape Card Stock
- Highland Heather Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Highland Heather Stampin' Pad
- Stamin' Blend Markers
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Gorgeous Grape card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut out two strips of one pattern from the Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper set, 3cm x 15cm (1-1/4" x 5-3/4"). Score down the middle of each strip, 1.5cm (5/8"). Fold in half and score. I cut these pieces slightly longer than my card length. I found it easier to trim the small excess off rather than risk cutting the strips too short.
- Glue one folded piece to the card 'spine' aligning the fold on the strip to the fold of the card. Glue the other strip to the right side with the card with the strip fold aligned with the right edge of the card front. There should be an equal amount of the DSP strip showing on the front and inside the card.
- Die cut the flower shapes out of a scrap white card stock. Color the die cuts using Stampin'Blend markers. I used the Light and Dark Highland Heather markers, the dark Shaded Spruce marker and the light Crumb cake marker.
- For the first layer (beneath the greeting) cut a rectangle out of a coordinating pattern from the Perennial Lavender Designer Series Paper to 5 cm x 10cm (2" x 4"). Adhere in place using the finished photo and card sketch to help with the position.
- Using a scrap of Basic White card stock, cut a rectangle to 5cm x 2.5cm (2" x 1"). Stamp the 'thank you' greeting from the Greenery Lane stamp set with Highland Heather ink. Cut a backing piece for the label out of Highland Heather card stock, 5.5cm x 3cm (2-1/4" x 1-1/4"). Center the white stamped rectangle in the center of the Heather rectangle, leaving a narrow border of the Heather piece showing all the way around.
- Adhere one of your flower the die cuts to the right edge of the back of the greeting piece and the other flower to the bottom left edge. Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting piece. Adhere the greeting unit to the card front using the photo and sketch for placement.
- Finish with a trio of Purple Fine Shimmer Gems.
