

Supplies

- Fabulous Sayings Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Exposed Brick 3-D Embossing Folder
- Gears and Textures Dies
- Square Snippets Designer Series Paper
- Secret Sea Card Stock
- Smoky Slate Card Stock
- Secret Sea Stampin' Pad
- Smoky Slate Stampin' Pad
- 2025-27 In Color Flat Pearls
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Dimensionals
- Brayer
- Blending Brush
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Secret Sea card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Smoky Slate card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut out two of the pattern squares from a piece of the Square Snippets Designer Series Paper set.
- Find the center point of the card front by lightly drawing a vertical line at 5.25cm (2-1/8") and a horizontal line at 7.4cm (2-5/8"). Use these lines to line up and adhere the squares to the card front. After the glue is dry trim off the excess DSP squares from the top and bottom.
- Die cut the gear & hash shapes, one each out of a scrap Smoky Slate and Secret card stock. You will have a total of four die cuts. Glue the darker color over the lighter color leaving some of the lighter color showing underneath and peaking through the open areas of the die cut.
- For the first layer (beneath the greeting) cut a rectangle out of Smoky Slate card stock to 5 cm x 10cm (2" x 4") Using a brayer roll Secret Sea ink onto the back side of the Exposed Brick embossing folder (the side without the Stampin'Up! logo). Place the Smoky Slate rectangle into the folder and emboss. Place down the die cut hash shape on the right (as shown in the photo) and then adhere the embossed piece to the card front, again using the finished photo and card sketch to help with the position.
- Using a scrap of Smoky Slate card stock, cut a rectangle to 8.3cm x 3.3cm (3-1/4" x 1-5/16"). Stamp the greeting from the Fabulous Sayings stamp set with Secret Sea ink. Brush the edges of the rectangle with a blending brush and Smoky Slate ink. Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting..
- Adhere the die cut gear to the bottom left on the greeting allowing about two-thirds of the gear to hang off. Place a couple of trimmed down mini dimensionals to help support the die cut. Adhere the greeting unit to the card front using the photo and sketch for placement.
- Finish with a Secret Sea flat pearls from the 2025-27 In Color Collection, affixed to the center of the gear.
