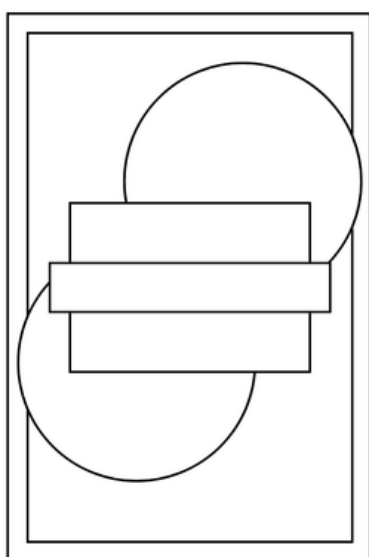

Supplies

- Fabulous Sayings Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Joyful Squares Dies
- Stylish Shapes Die Set
- Paradise Garden Embossing Folder
- Square Snippets Designer Series Paper
- Pretty In Pink Card Stock
- Cajun Craze 12 x 12 Double Sided Card Stock
- Basic Vanilla Card Stock
- Pretty In Pink Stampin' Pad
- Pack Your Bags Twine Three Pack
- Iridescent Foil Gems
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Dimensionals
- Sand paper/sanding block
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Pretty In Pink card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic Vanilla card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut a rectangle from a piece of the Square Snippets Designer Series Paper measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the center of your card front leaving an equal border of card stock showing on all sides.
- Die cut two 7cm (2-3/4") circles from two different but coordinating squares from the Square Snippets Designer Series Paper. I used circles from the Stylish Shapes dies set but you could use a punch or fussy cut circles. Glue these circles flat to the card front using the finished photo as a guide.
- Next cut a small rectangle of Cajun Craze card stock, measuring 8cm x 4.5cm (3-1/8" x 1-3/4"). Emboss this piece using the Paradise Garden 3-D embossing folder. Lightly sand the tops of the embossing to expose the white core of the card stock. Wrap a length of the pink bakers twine from the Pack Your Bags set several times around the center of the rectangle and secure at the back with cello tape.
- For the greeting cut a square of Vanilla card stock to 4.8cm x 4.8cm (1-7/8 x 1-7/8") Stamp the greeting in Pretty In Pink ink. The greeting I used is from the Fabulous Sayings photopolymer stamp set. Cut a square from a scrap of Pretty In Pink measuring 4.2cm x 4.2cm (1-3/4 x 1-3/4"). Adhere this to the back of the greeting leaving a narrow pink border showing.
- Die cut the clip shape from the Joyful Squares dies set two times out of the Pretty In Pink card stock. Glue one to the top of the back of the greeting and one to the front of the greeting piece. Thread another length of the pink bakers twine through the hole and tie the two ends together. Loop the ends under the twine on the Cajun Craze square and tie in place. See finished photo for placement.
- Place dimensionals on the back side of the embossed Cajun Craze piece. Note: I used quite a few dimensionals because this card stock is a bit thinner than the card stock used for the card base. Adhere to the card front over the circles. Again see finished photo.
- Finish with a trio of Iridescent Foil Gems.
