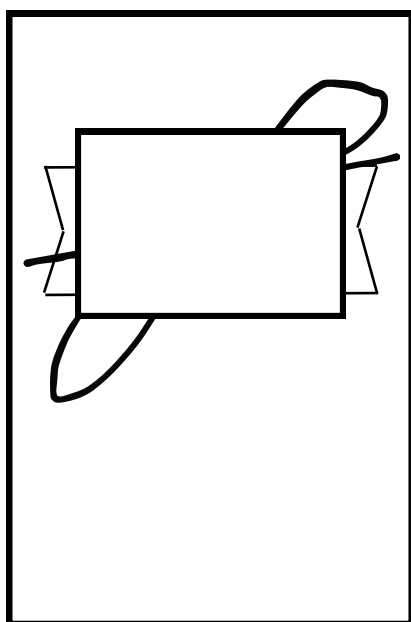

Supplies

- Frames and Phrases Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Frames and Phrases Dies
- Artisan Sketched Garden Designer Series Paper
- Basic Black Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Real Red Card Stock
- Basic Black Hybrid Stampin' Pad
- Iridescent Pearls Basic Jewles
- Stampin' Blend Marker-Real Red
- Stampin' Blend Marker - Shaded Spruce
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Basic Black card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- Cut a piece of the Artisan Sketched Garden Designer Series Paper to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere this piece flat to the card front leaving an equal border of the black showing all the way around.
- Die cut the the frame out of a scrap of basic white card stock, you will only need the center portion for this project. Stamp your greeting onto the oval and set aside.
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- Next use the same die and cut out the frame from a scrap of black card stock. Leave the frame in the die, and discard the oval center piece. Place the die face up on your cutting plate with the card stock frame still on it. Place the Impressions Mat over the die, place the alternative gray plate on the top of the mat. (This is the plate that you usually use with embossing folders.) Run the sandwich through the machine. Rubber mat will press the paper on the die cut into the die and create texture.
- The background strip behind the frame is cut from a scrap of Real Red. The dimensions are 9cm x 3cm (3-1/2" x 1-3/16"). I rounded the corners slightly but this is optional.
- Adhere the black frame to the center of the red strip. Place dimensionals on the back of the white oval greeting piece and place in the center of the black frame.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting piece along the red strip. Adhere to the card front. Use the finished photo or or card sketch for placement.
- Using the Stampin' Blend markers color in the most central of the groups of flowers.
- Because of the busy background I choose not to use the ribbon/string element seen in the card sketch.
- I finished the card with a trio of Iridescent Pearls Baisc Jewles .
