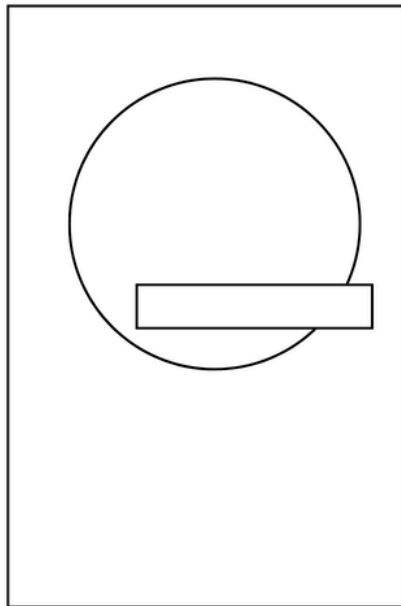

Supplies

- Balloon Festoon Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Balloon Festoon Dies
- Nature Walk Designer Series Paper
- Garden Green Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Garden Green Stampin' Pad
- Bakers Twine Essentials
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a bottom opening card base 10.5cm x 29.7cm (4-1/4" x 11") from the Garden Green card stock. Score at 14.55cm (5-1/5"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut a piece of the Nature Walk Designer Series paper to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere flat to the front of the card leaving a narrow border of the base showing on all sides.
- From a scrap of the Garden Green card stock die cut one of the large balloons from the Balloon Festoon die set. Optional: brush some of the Garden Green along the edges of the balloon on the bottom and right side to create a bit of shadow.
- Die cut the coordinating balloon highlight piece from a scrap of the white card stock. Adhere flat to to the balloon. Use the finished card photo as a reference if necessary.
- Stamp the greeting from the Balloon Festoon stamp set in Garden Green onto white card stock. I did not really measure this. I just cut the card stock close the stamped greeting and then cut notches out of each end.
- Tie a small piece of the white baker's twine from the Baker's Twine Essentials set around the bottom of the balloon.
- Adhere the balloon to the front of the card using Stampin Dimensionals. Place a dimensional on the back of the right side of the greeting. Glue the left half of the greeting over the balloon so that it lays flat while the right side is raised up to the same level of the balloon with the dimensional on the back.
- Optional: Place a small amount of glue on the bottom right of the card and glue down the end of the twine.
