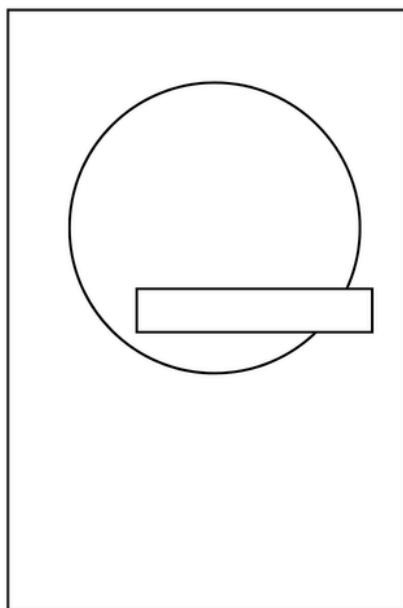


## Happy Birthday June Card Sketch

### Supplies

- Scalloped Blooms Photopolymer Stamp Set
- All Aflutter Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Spotlight on Nature Dies
- Blossom Boutique Designer Series Paper
- Barely Blush Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Vellum
- Versa Mark Stampin' Pad
- Wow Gold Embossing Powder
- Stampin' Blend Markers
- Barely Blush 3/8" Bordered Ribbon
- Stampin' Blend Markers
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Glue Dots
- All Aflutter Punch
- Heat Gun
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

## Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 ( 8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Blue Berry Bushel card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut a piece of the Blossom Boutique Designer Series paper to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere flat to the front of the card leaving a narrow border of the base showing on all sides.
- Using a 7cm (2-3/4") circle die (from either the Spotlight on Nature dies or the Stylish Shape dies) cut out a circle from the upper right area of the card base. Cut through the Designer Series Paper and the card stock. Use the finished photo/card sketch for help with circle placement.
- Close the card and draw a very light pencil line around the die cut hole. This will help you in the placement of the greeting.
- Stamp the greeting with versa mark ink inside the circle you just drew. Sprinkle over the gold embossing powder and heat set.
- Tie a small bow with the Barley There Bordered Ribbon and adhere with a glue dot just below the greeting. Be sure the bow does not interfere with the opening of the card. Erase your pencil line.
- Stamp the outline butterfly stamp from the All Aflutter Photopolymer Stamp Set with the Versa Mark ink onto a scrap of vellum . Sprinkle the gold embossing powder over the image and heat set the powder.
- Punch out the butterflies using the matching All Aflutter Punch. Optionally, color the butterflies using Stampin' Blend Markers; I used colors, Barely There, Crisp Cantaloupe and Hydrangea Hue. I tried the butterflies with and without color and I preferred with but you do you!
- Fold the butterflies in half gently creasing them. Adhere them to the card front with a glue dot placed on the crease line. Be patient with this step as the glue dots do not seem to like sticking the the vellum and the vellum is 'slippery'. I found using my Take Your Pick tool to press directly onto the small spot where the glue dot attached to the vellum and paper, worked to hold them in place long enough for the dot to stick.
