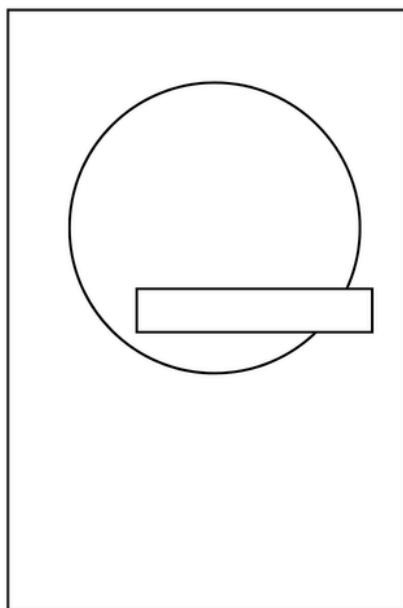

Supplies

- Paradise Garden Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Paradise Garden Dies
- Scalloped Blooms Dies
- Garden Poetry Designer Series Paper
- Garden Textures Specialty Paper
- Blueberry Bushel Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Blueberry Bushel Stampin' Pad
- Garden Epoxy Dots
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a bottom opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Blueberry Bushel card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut a piece of the Garden Poetry Designer Series paper to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere flat to the front of the card leaving a narrow border of the base showing on all sides.
- From a scrap of the Garden Textures Specialty Paper, die cut a scalloped circle using the 7cm (2-3/4") scalloped die.
- Stamp the leaves from the Paradise Garden Photopolymer Stamp Set onto a scrap of white card stock. I used the stamp off method to lighten the leaves to match the Designer Series Paper background. Die cut out the leaves using the coordinating Paradise Garden Dies.
- Stamp the greeting from the Paradise Garden Photopolymer Stamp Set using the Blueberry Bushel ink onto another scrap of white card stock. Die cut out the greeting using the coordinating Paradise Garden Dies.
- Adhere the leaves and greeting strip onto the scalloped circle. Place dimensionals on the back side of the unit and affix to the front of the card as shown.
- Finish with a trio of the Garden Epoxy Dots.
