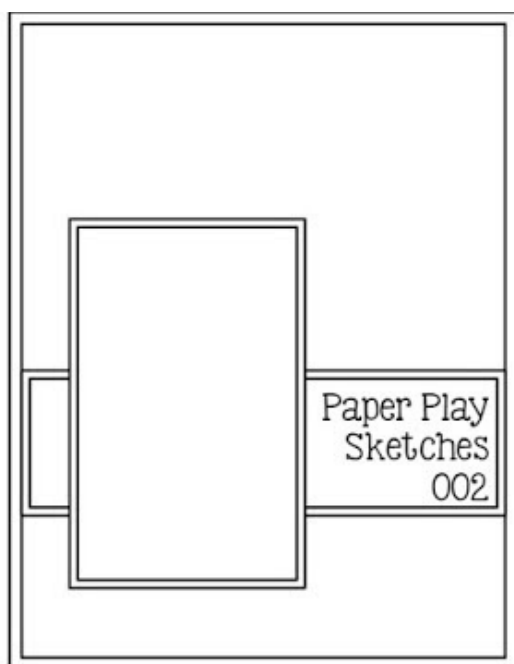

## Eyelet Bloom May Card Sketch



### Supplies

- Boutique Blossoms Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Boutique Blossoms Dies
- Eyelet Bloom Die
- Painted Illusions Designer Series Paper
- Flirty Flamingo Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Flirty Flamingo Stampin' Pad
- Barely Blush Bordered Ribbon
- 2026-28 In Color Butterflies
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

**Directions**

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 ( 8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Flirty Flamingo card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut a large rectangle from a piece of Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 11cm (4" x 4"). Die cut this piece using the large background Eyelet Bloom die. Cut the rectangle into two pieces, the first measuring 10cm x 7.5cm (4" x 2-3/4") and the second measuring 10cm x 3.5cm (4" x 1-1/4").
- From a scrap of the Painted Illusions Designer Series Paper cut a long rectangle measuring 10cm x 3cm (4" x 1").
- Adhere the large white die cut rectangle on the upper portion of the card front, the Designer Series Paper strip next and the second die cut white piece at the bottom. See the finished photo or card sketch to help you position the pieces.
- Cut a rectangle out of a scrap of the Flirty Flamingo card stock to 5.4cm x 8.9cm (2-1/8" x 3-1/4").
- Cut another rectangle out of basic white to 5cm x 8.5cm (1-7/8" x 3"). Center this rectangle over the Flirty Flamingo rectangle cut in the previous step. There should be a narrow border of the the Flirty Flamingo showing all the way around the white. Using dimensionals adhere this piece to the card front as shown in the pictures.
- Die cut the large rose shape out of a scrap of Flirty Flamingo card stock. Next die cut the leaves, one of the leaf shapes was die cut from Soft Sea Foam card stock and the other from a scrap of Peaceful Pine card stock.
- Cut a small strip of the Barely Blush Bordered Ribbon and fold it in half.
- Adhere the die cuts and the strip of ribbon to the white and Flirty Flamingo layered rectangle piece using dimensionals. You can use the finished photo for placement ideas.
- Finish with a trio of 2026-28 In Color Butterflies.
