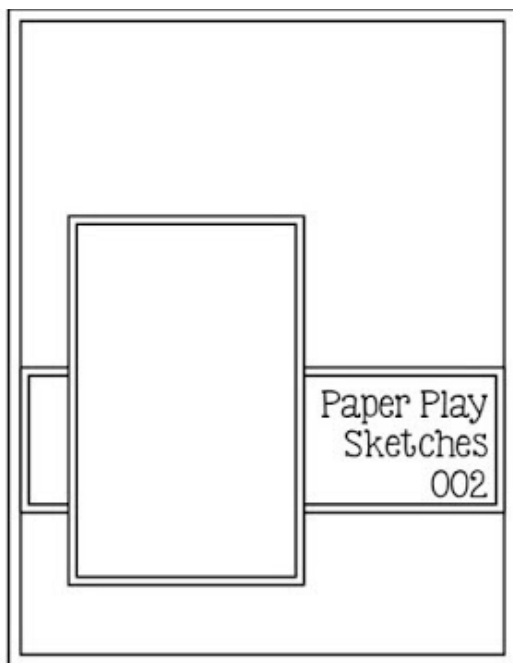

## Lovely Day May Card Sketch



### Supplies

- Paradise Garden Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Garden Poetry Designer Series Paper
- Garden Textures Specialty Foil
- Blueberry Bushel Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Blueberry Bushell Stampin' Pad
- Bordered Open Weave Ribbon
- Garden Exoxy Dots
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer

## Directions

- Cut a right side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 ( 8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Blueberry Bushel card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Optionally, but recommended, cut a card liner from Basic White card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- For the background, cut two rectangles from a piece of the Garden Poetry Designer Series Paper measuring 10cm x 7.5cm (4" x 2-3/4") and 10cm x 3.5cm (4" x 1-1/4").
- From a scrap of the Garden Textures Specialty Foil cut two rectangles, the first measuring 10cm x 3cm (4" x 1") and the second measuring 5.4cm x 8.9cm (2-1/8" x 3-1/4"). Set aside the larger rectangle for the moment.
- Adhere the larger rectangle to the upper portion of your card front. Be sure there is the same amount of border on the top and each side. (See finished photo). Next adhere the foil long rectangle (measuring 10cm x 3cm (4" x 1")) just below the large DSP rectangle, aligning them from side to side. There should now be an equal amount of Highland Heather showing all the way around the large DSP rectangle. Adhere the last and smaller DSP rectangle below the Foil strip. Align the sides with the upper two rectangles. There should be an equal border of the Blueberry Bushel showing around all sides of this smaller rectangle. Note: this is the place to adjust the borders if necessary.
- Cut a rectangle out of a scrap of the Basic White card stock to 5cm x 8.5cm (1-7/8" x 3"). Stamp your greeting and leaf images onto the white using Blueberry Bushel ink. Layer this piece over the Foil Rectangle you set aside in step number No. 4. Leave an equal border of the foil showing all of the way around the piece.
- Tie a bow with a length of Bordered Open Weave Ribbon and adhere to the bottom of the layered rectangle. Place dimensionals on the back and adhere to the card front as showing in the finished photo.
- Finish with a trio of Garden Epoxy Dots.
