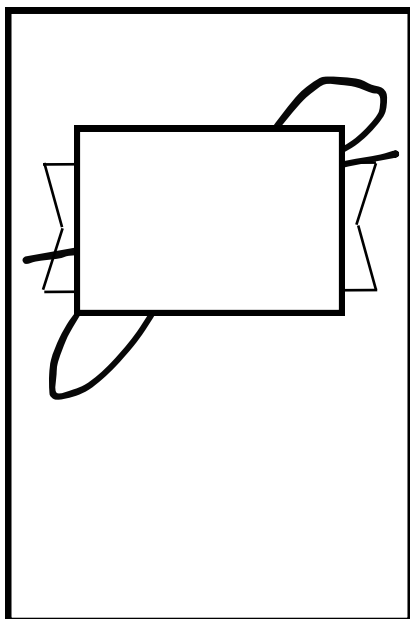

Supplies

- Festoon Ballons Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Stylish Shapes Dies
- Nature Walk Designer Series Paper
- Pecan Pie Card Stock
- Basic Vanilla Card Stock
- Pecan Pie Stampin' Pad
- Early Espresso Stampin' Pad
- Faux Bronze Pentagons
- Linen Thread
- Blending Brush
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a bottom opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Pecan Pie card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Cut a card liner from Basic Vanilla card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- Cut a piece of the Nature Walk Designer Series Paper to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere this piece flat to the card front leaving an equal border of the black showing all the way around.
- Die cut a square out of the basic vanilla card stock using the 6cm x 6cm (2-1/2" x 2-1/2") square die from the Stylish Shapes die set. Stamp the greeting from the Balloon Festoon stamp set using Early Espresso ink. With a blender brush and the pecan pie ink brush the edges of the square.
- Next use the largest flag shaped die from the Stylish Shapes set and cut one out using a scrap of the Pecan Pie card stock. Brush the upper and lower edges with the pecan pie ink. No need to do the whole length as it will be covered up.
- Adhere the flag piece in the vertical position, flat to the card front. See finished photo.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the vanilla greeting piece. Affix to the card front centered over the vertical flag shape.
- Finish card with a bow tied with linen thread and five of the Faux Bronze Pentagons.
