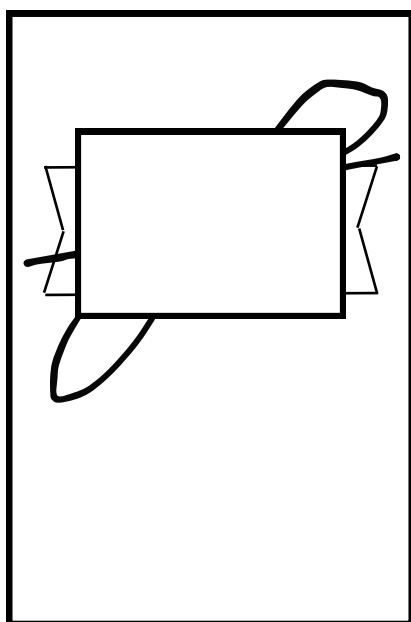

Supplies

- Frames and Phrases Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Perennial Postage Dies
- Berry Botanical Vellum
- Basic White Card Stock
- Blue Berry Bushel Card Stock
- Blueberry Bushel Stampin' Pad
- Hydrangea Hue Bordered Ribbon
- 2027-28 In Color Butterflies
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Basic white card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Cut a piece of the Berry Botanical Vellum to 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere this piece flat to the card front leaving an equal border of the white showing all the way around. To attach the vellum I used a line of glue under where I would be putting the greeting. The edges were left free to float and slightly curl. As always when gluing/adhering vellum be aware that most adhesives will show through, so be sure to hide it when ever possible.
- Die cut the the greeting out of a scrap of basic white card stock. Stamp your greeting using the Blueberry Bushel ink.
- Cut a strip of Blueberry Bushel card stock measuring, 9cm x 2.5cm (3-9/16" x 1"). To create the 'flag end' place a pencil mark from the center each end of the strip and extend the mark down to approximately .5cm (1/4"). Clip this mark. Now clip from each of the corners down to the end of your clip mark and remove and discard the little triangle pieces.
- Adhere the Bluberry Bushel piece to the center of the back of the white greeting.
- Cut a length of the Hydrangea Hue ribbon and loop it behind the greeting unit. I secured the ribbon in place with a bit of cello tape but since it does not show you can really use anything here.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting piece. Adhere to the card front. Use the finished photo or or card sketch for placement.
- I finished the card with a trio of the In Color Butterflies .
