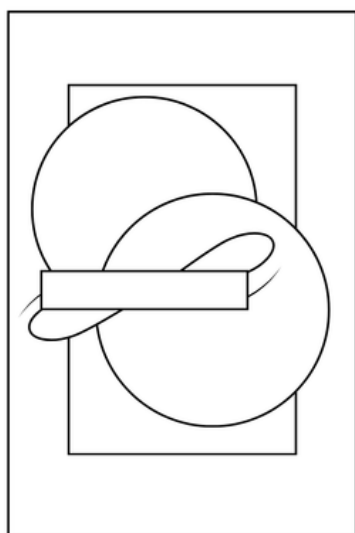

Supplies

- Wild Bunch Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Reasons to Celebrate Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Scalloped Blooms Dies
- Barely Blush Card Stock
- Basic White Card Stock
- Barely Blush Stampin' Pad
- Gray Granite or Basic Black Stampin' Pad
- Stampin'Blend Markers
- 2026-28 In Color Butterflies
- Barely Blush Bordered Ribbon
- Stampin' Up Masking Paper
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Stampin' Positioner
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Barely Blush card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Cut a card liner from basic white card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- Cut three strips of the masking paper, 2cm (3/4") wide. Place one strip on each side of the card front lining up the strip with the edge on one side and the fold of the card on the other side. Cut the third strip in half and align one piece along the top edge and one along the bottom edge. You should now have a 2cm (3/4") border masked off.
- Using the scribbled squares stamp from the Wild Bunch set and the Barely Blush ink, stamp the image repeatedly in the masked off area. I used the Stampin' Positioner to help me keep the squares straight.
- Before removing the masking paper draw a line around the stamped area. It is ok if the line is a little messy, it will match the stamp. Carefully remove the masking paper.
- Stamp two of the characters on white card stock. I used Gray Granite ink, In retrospect I wish I had used black ink I think it would have made the image easier to color in. Color in the images using Stampin' Blend Markers.
- Die cut the images using the medium sized scallop die. Place dimensionals on the back of the scalloped circles and place onto the card front. You can look at the finished image for placement.
- From a scrap of Barely Blush card stock cut a rectangle 8.8cm x 1.5cm (3-1/2" x 3/8").
- Stamp the Birthday Greeting from the Reasons to Celebrate stamp set onto a scrap of basic white using the Barely Blush ink. Cut the greeting to 8.8cm x 1.5cm (3-1/2" x 3/8"). Layer this piece on top of the small Barely Blush rectangle.
- Cut a piece of the Barely Blush ribbon, loop it and affix to the back of the greeting piece.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting piece and adhere to the card front. Use the finished photo for placement.
- Finish the card with a trio of butterflies.
