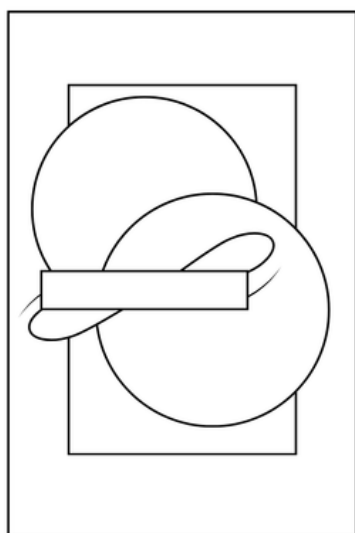

Supplies

- Nature's Symphony Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Nature's Symphony Dies
- Balloon Festoon Photopolymer Stamp Set
- Natural Hues Textured Specialty Paper
- Pecan Pie Card Stock
- Peaceful Pine Card Stock
- Very Vanilla Card Stock
- Peaceful Pine Stampin' Pad
- Peaceful Pine Bordered Ribbon
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Cut and Emboss Machine

Directions

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 (8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the Pecan Pie card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- Cut a card liner from Very Vanilla card stock measuring 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4"). Adhere to the inside of the card.
- Cut a piece of the Natural Hues Textured Specialty Paper to 7.5cm x 11.2cm (3" x 4-3/8").
- Stamp the large foliage image from the Nature's Symphony stamp set onto a large scrap of Peaceful Pine card stock, use the Peaceful Pine ink to create the tone-on-tone effect. Die cut out this piece using the matching die. Glue this piece to the top portion of the Nature Hues rectangle cut in the step above. Be sure leave a bit of the die cut hanging off the sides for dimension.
- Die cut the other large image from the Nature's Symphony die set out the of the same Peaceful Pine card stock. Glue this piece to the below the the first die cut onto the Nature Hues rectangle. You can look at the finished image for placement.
- Place dimensionas on the back of the Nature Hues rectangle and affix to the center of the card.
- From a scrap of Pecan Pie card stock cut a small rectangle 7.5cm x 3cm (3"x 1-1/4").
- Stamp the Birthday Greeting from the Balloon Festoon stamp set onto a scrap of the Nature Hues Textured paper using the Peaceful Pine ink. Cut the greeting to 7cm x 2.5cm (2-3/4" x 1"). Layer this piece on top of the small Pecan Pie rectangle. Note: The ink did 'feather' a bit on the textured card stock. I was not bothered by this as I liked the additional texture. However if you don't care for this look you can stamp the greeting onto a piece of vanilla card stock.
- Cut a piece of the Peaceful Pine ribbon, loop it and affix to the back of the greeting piece.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting piece and adhere to the card front. Use the finished photo or or card sketch for placement.
