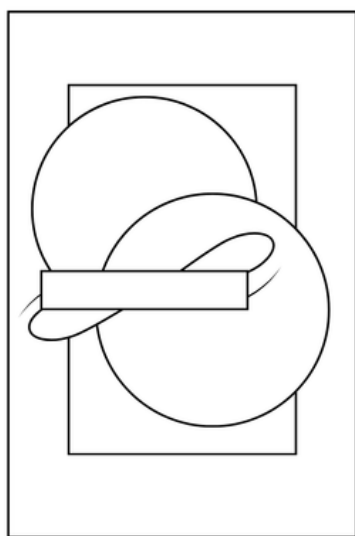

### Supplies

- Paradise Garden Hybrid Embossing Folder
- Stylish Shapes Dies
- Classic Greetings Hot Foil Dies
- Garden Poetry Designer Series Papers
- Garden Textures Specialty Foil
- Basic White Card Stock
- Gold Foil
- Gold & Silver Trim Combo
- Multipurpose Liquid Glue
- Stampin' Dimensionals
- Paper Trimmer
- Hot Foil System
- Cut and Emboss Machine

**Directions**

- Cut a side opening card base 21cm x 14.85 ( 8-1/2" x 5-1/2") from the basic white card stock. Score at 10.5cm (4-1/4"). Fold and burnish well.
- A card liner is not needed for this card however some designers prefer the weight of a card that has a liner. If you wish to have a liner the common size is 10cm x 14.35cm (4" x 5-1/4").
- Cut a piece of the Garden Poetry Designer Paper to 7.5cm x 11.2cm (2-3/4" x 3-7/8"). Adhere flat to the center of the front of the card base.
- Cut two circles from the Garden Textures Specialty Foil. I used the 6.3cm (2-1/2") circles from the Stylish Shapes die set. It is best to cut the circles first. If you die cut after embossing it can flatten the embossing.
- Place the circles in the embossing folder and run through the Cut and Emboss Machine.
- Glue these circles flat to the card front. See the finished photo or card sketch for placement.
- Cut a scrap of white card stock large enough to fit the greeting and leave a large border. Follow the directions on your Hot Foil system to emboss the greeting in gold. Cut out the greeting using the matching die.
- Cut a length of the gold trim from the Gold & Silver Trim Combo pack. Either tie a large loose bow or just loop the ribbon behind the die cut greeting and secure down.
- Place dimensionals on the back of the greeting piece and adhere to the card front. Use the finished photo or or card sketch for placement.
